

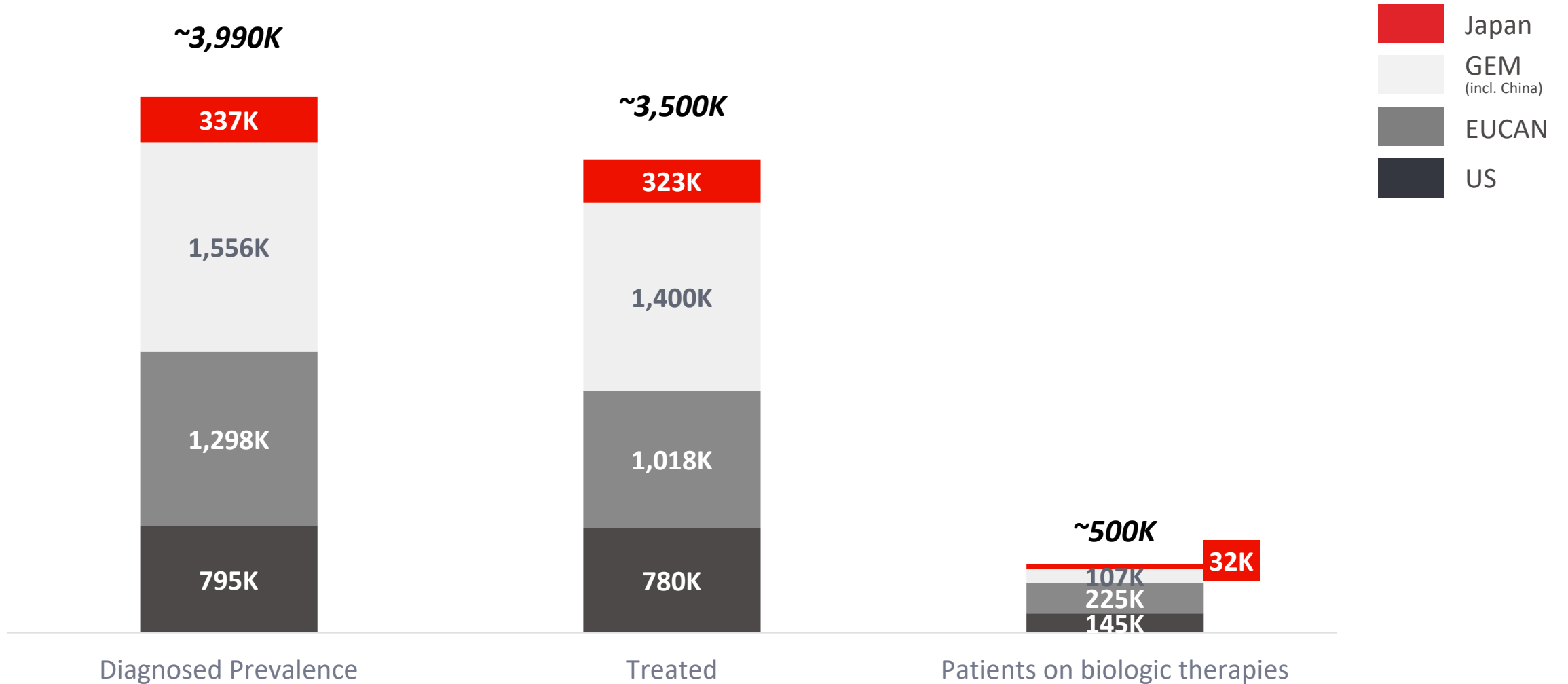

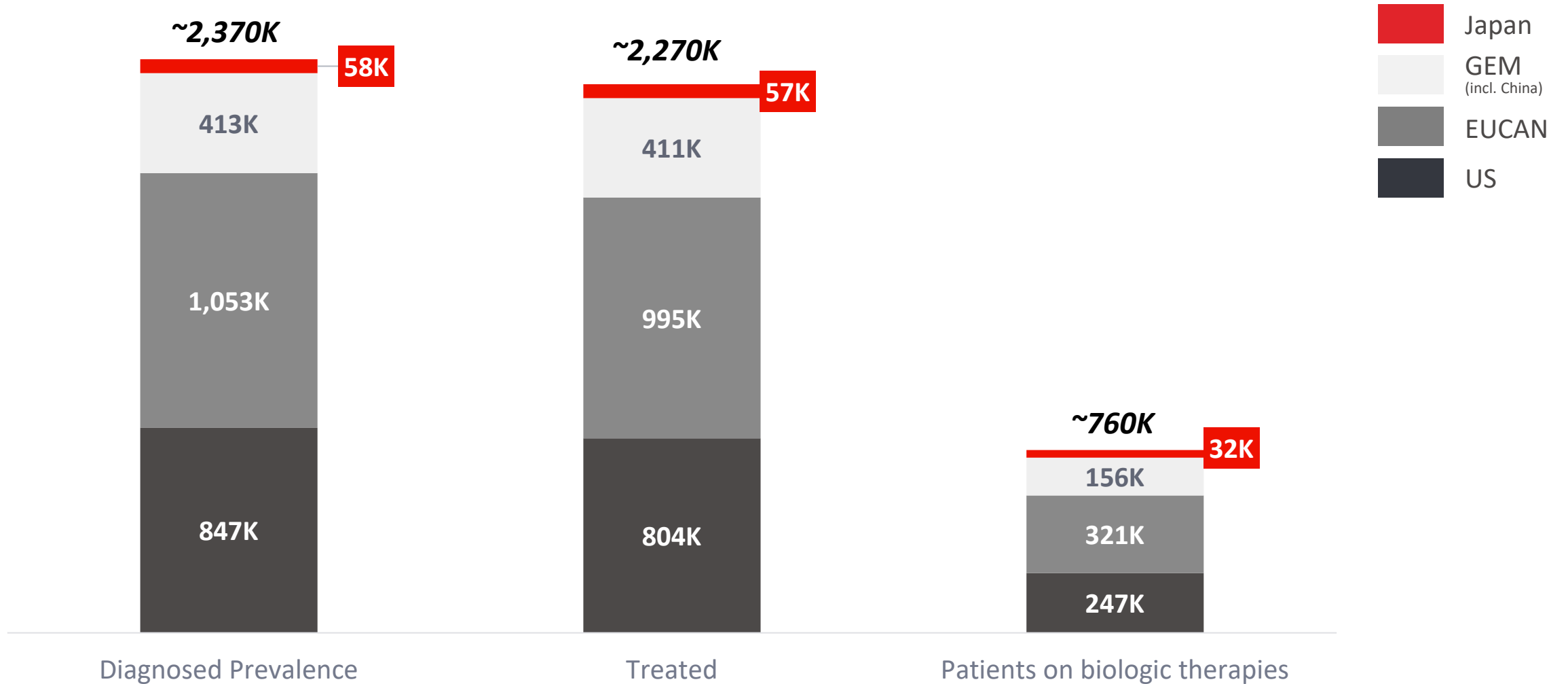

EPIDEMIOLOGY ULCERATIVE COLITIS (UC)



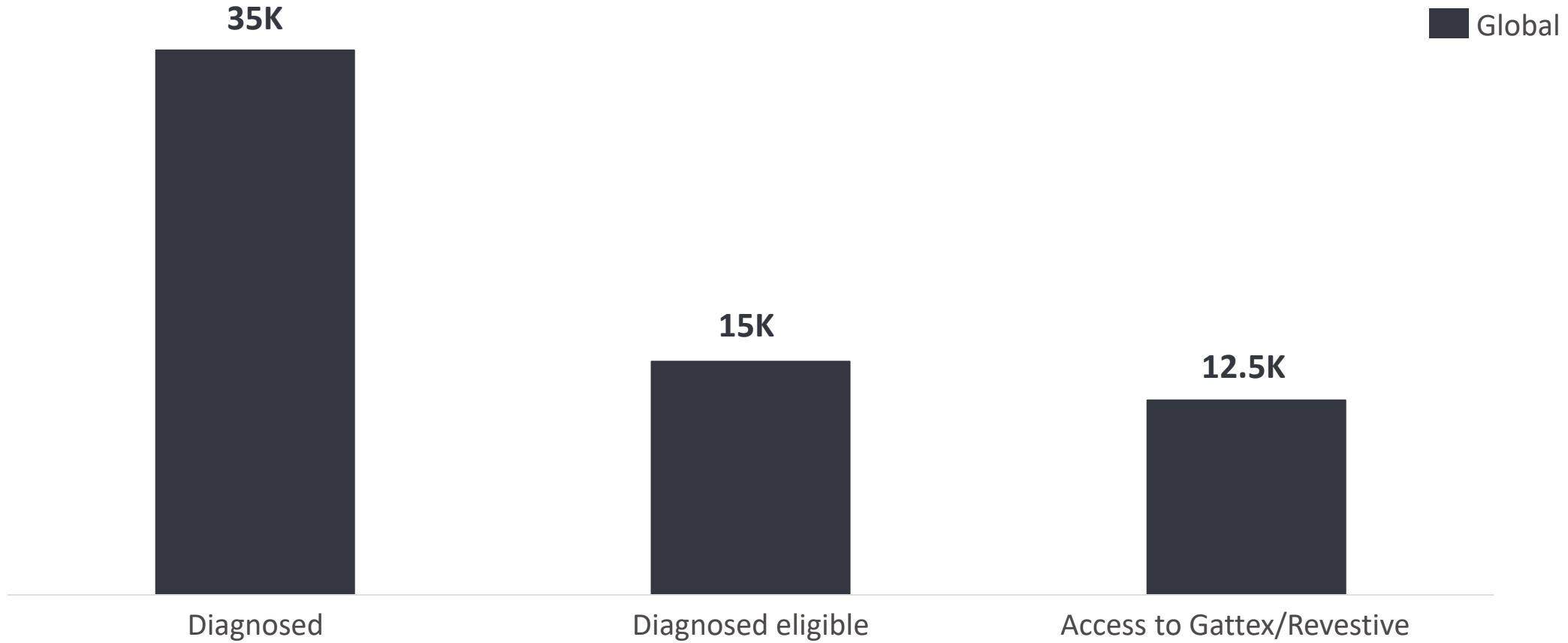

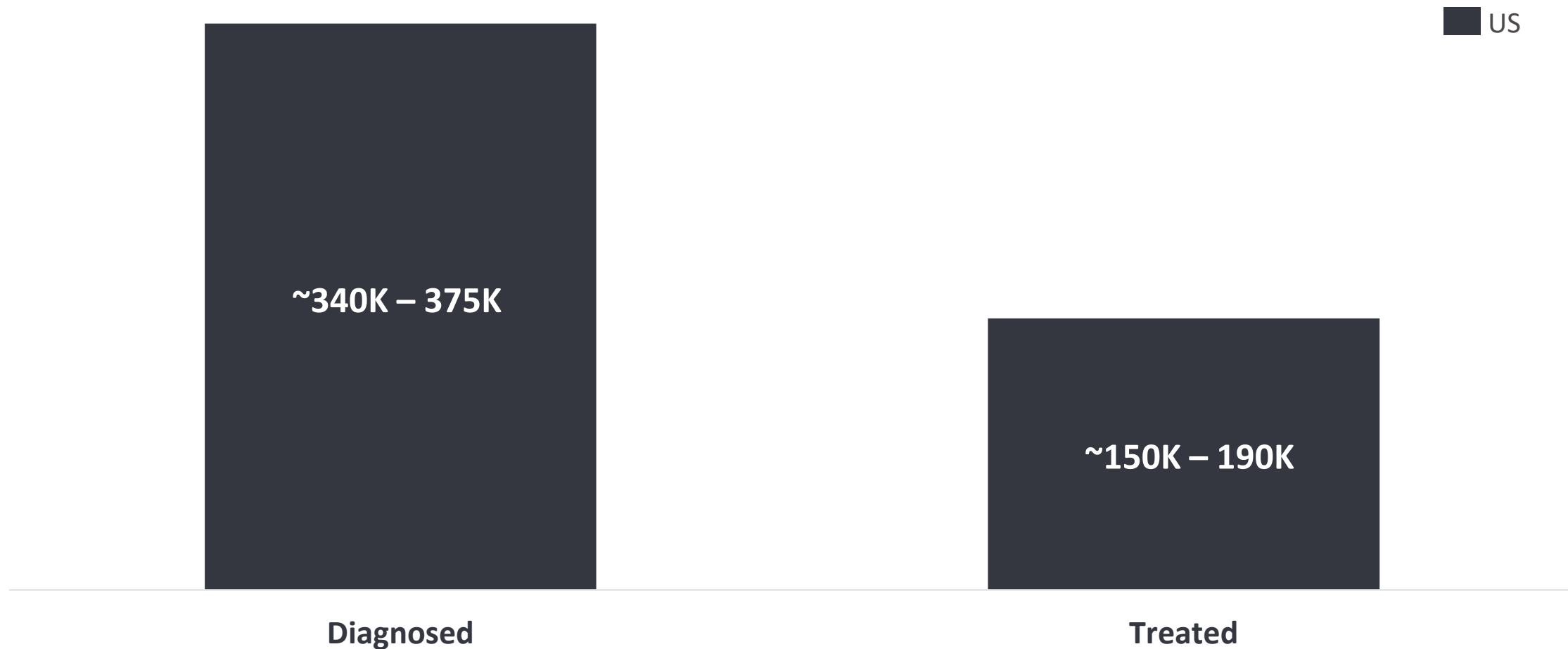

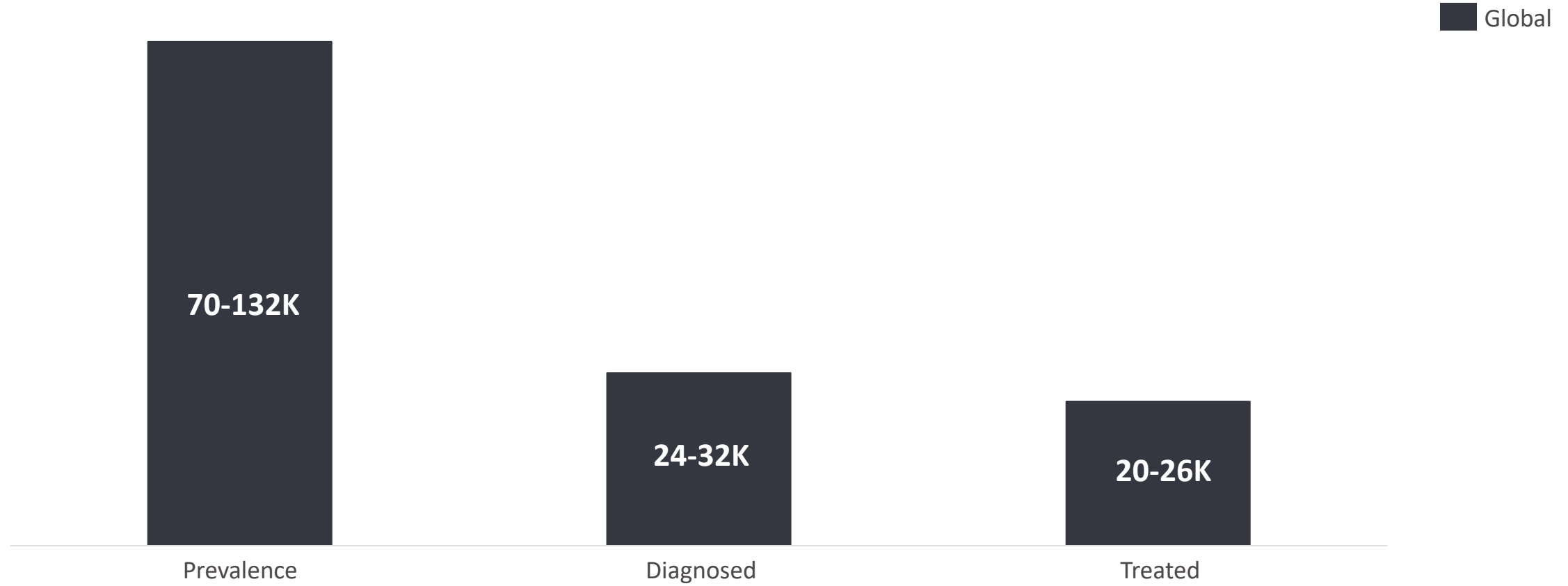

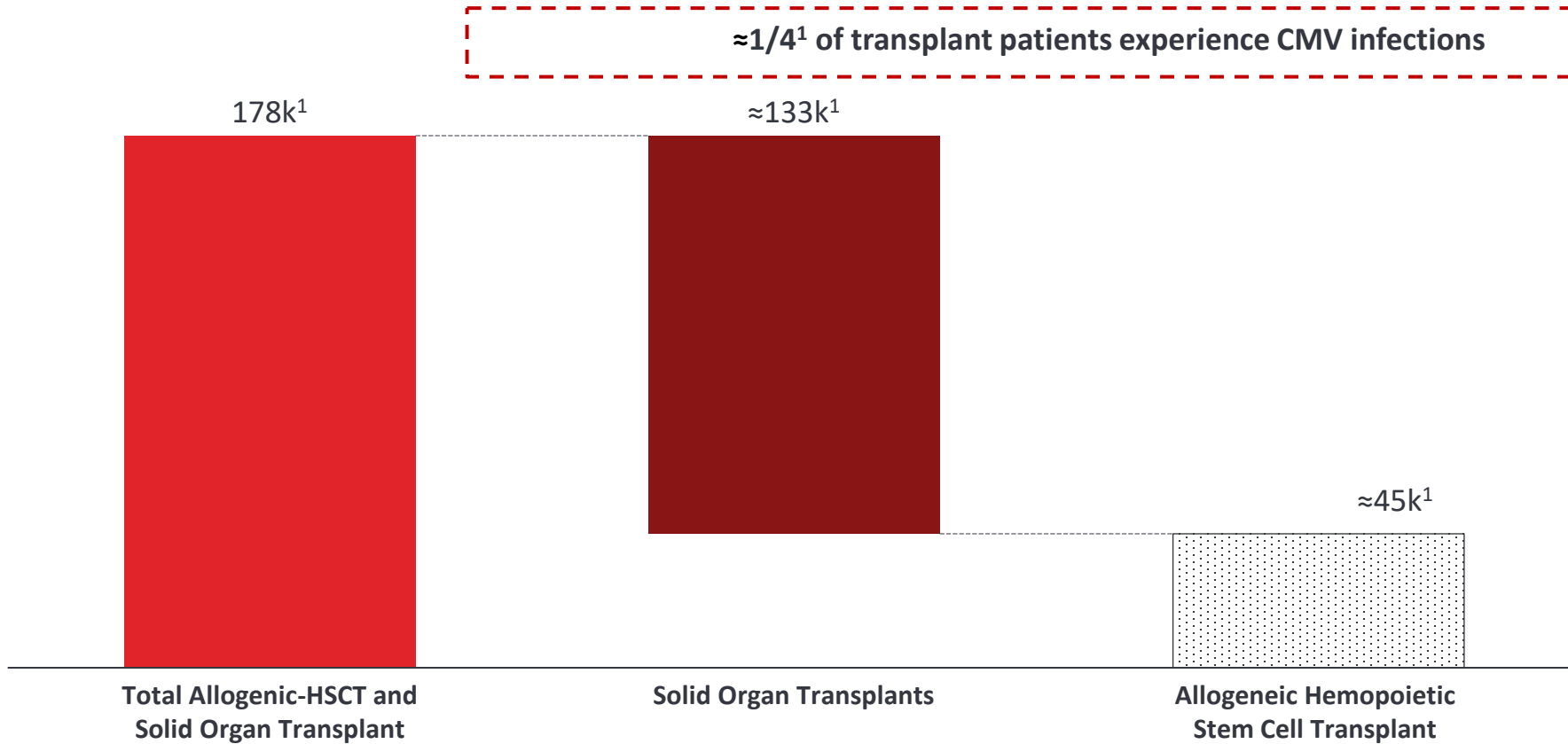

CMV infection in post-transplant patients are 100% diagnosed & treated

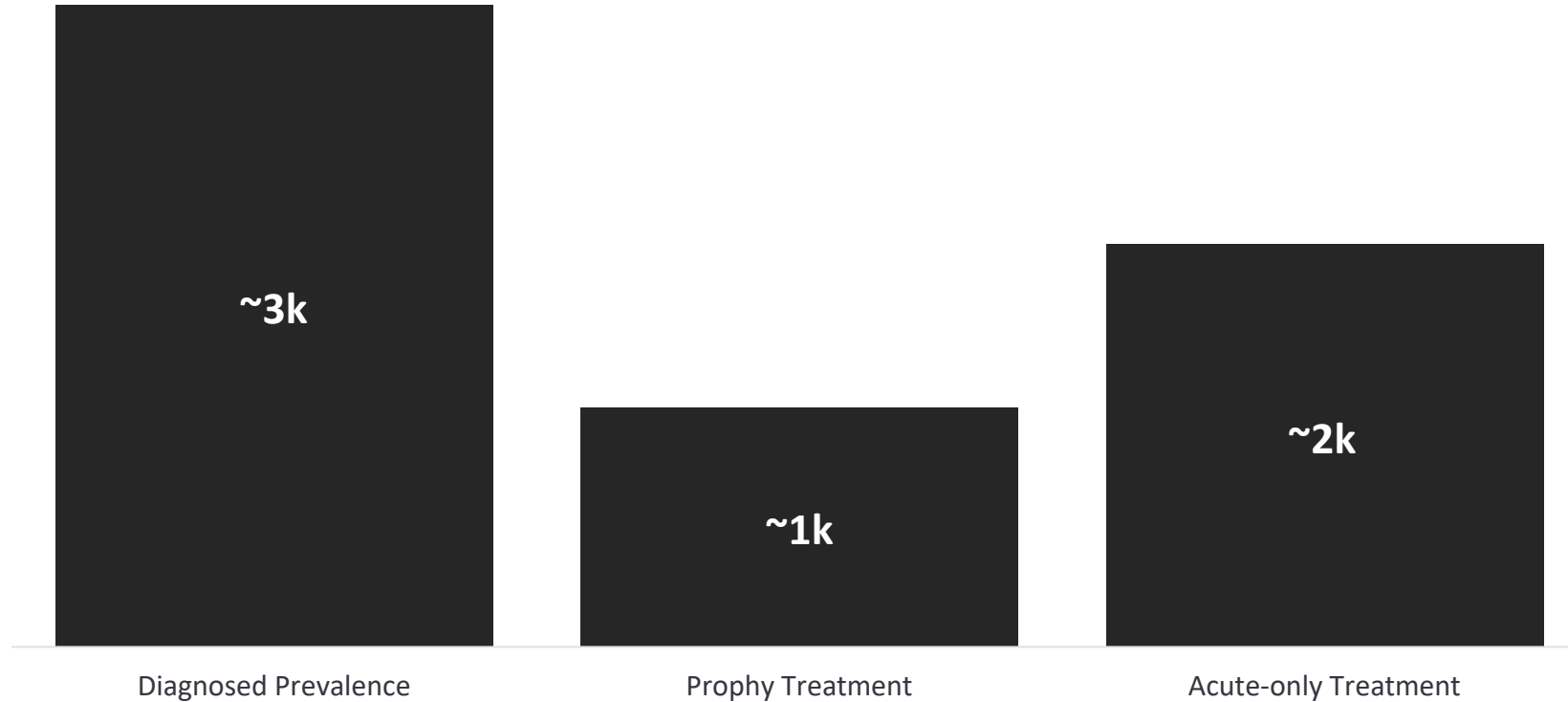

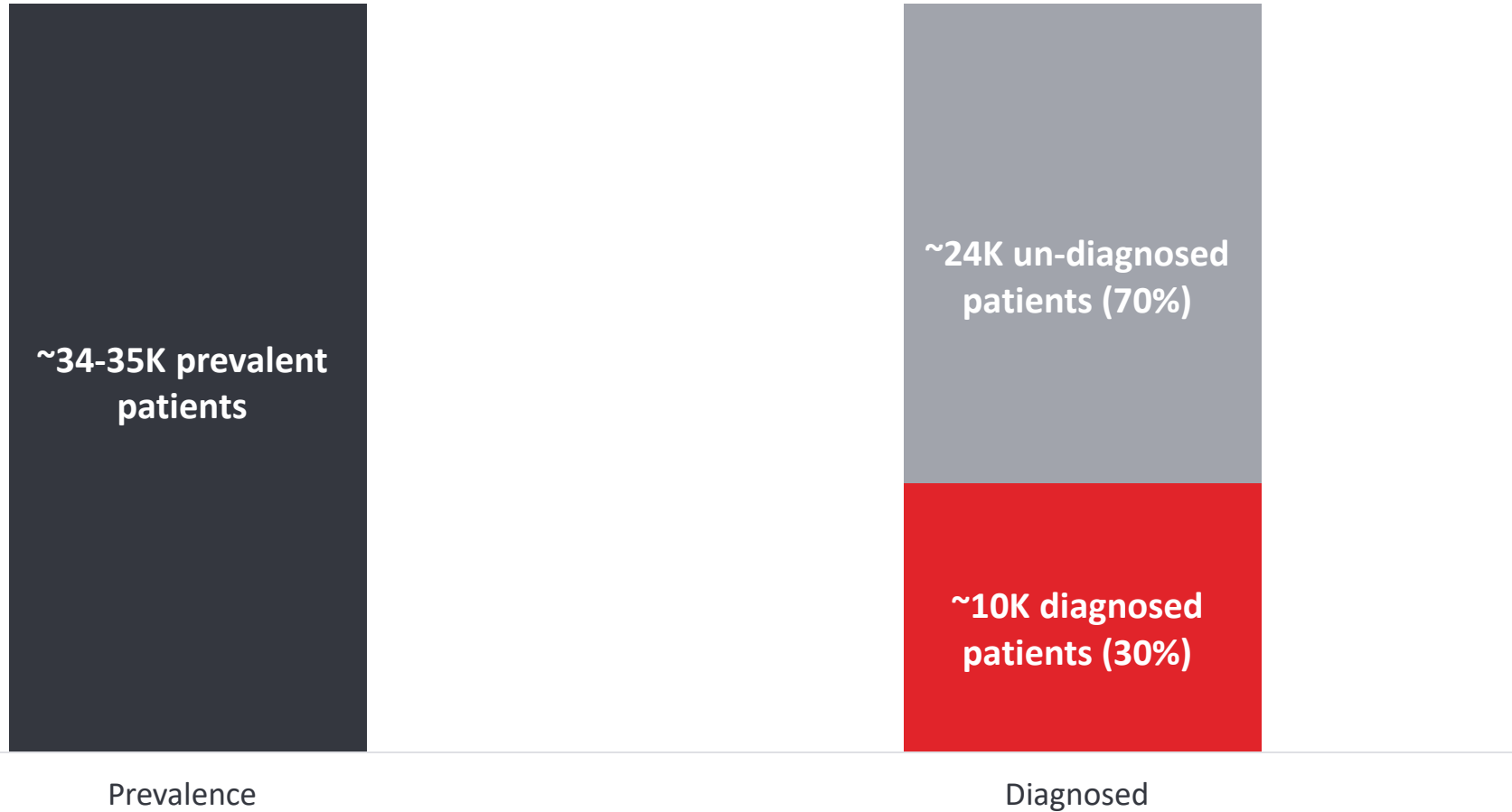
Diagnosed Prevalence

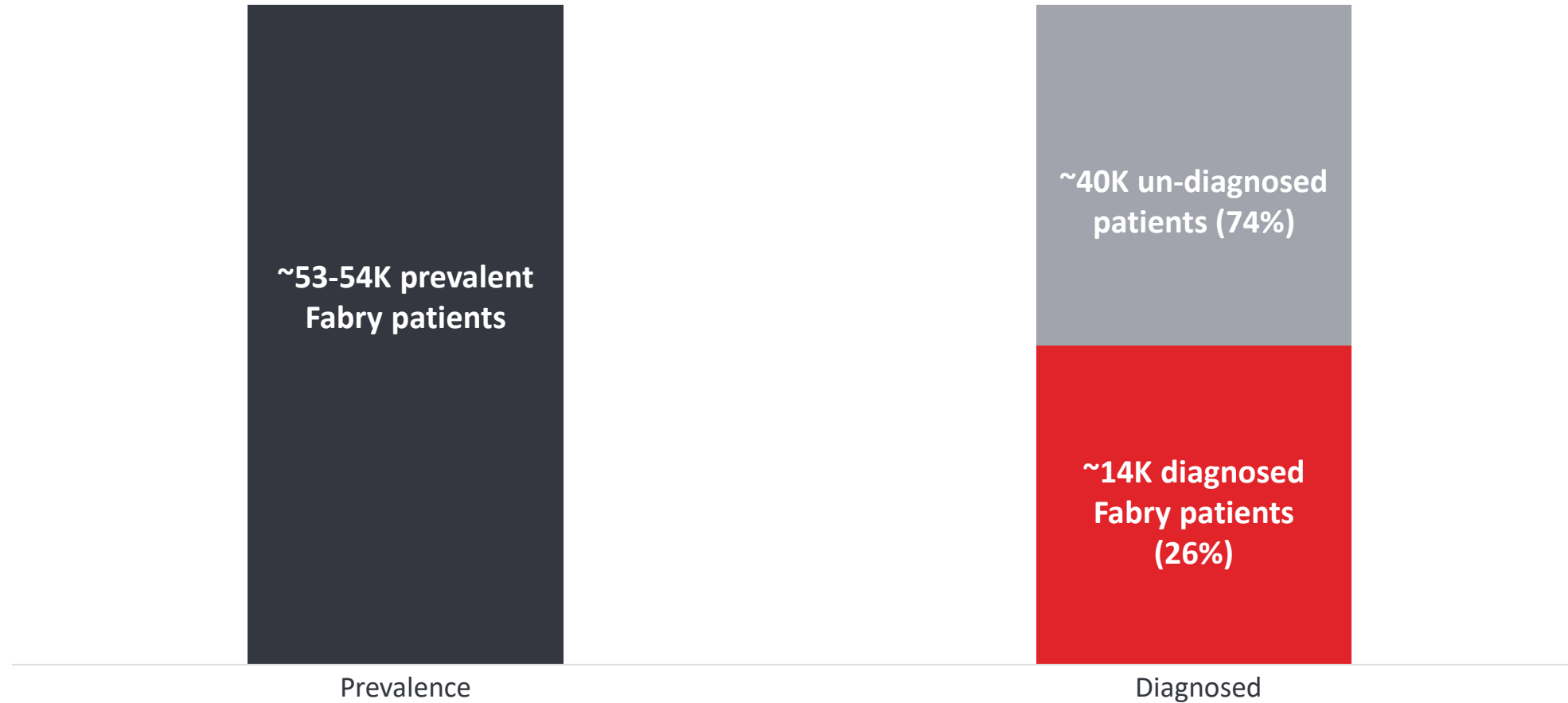

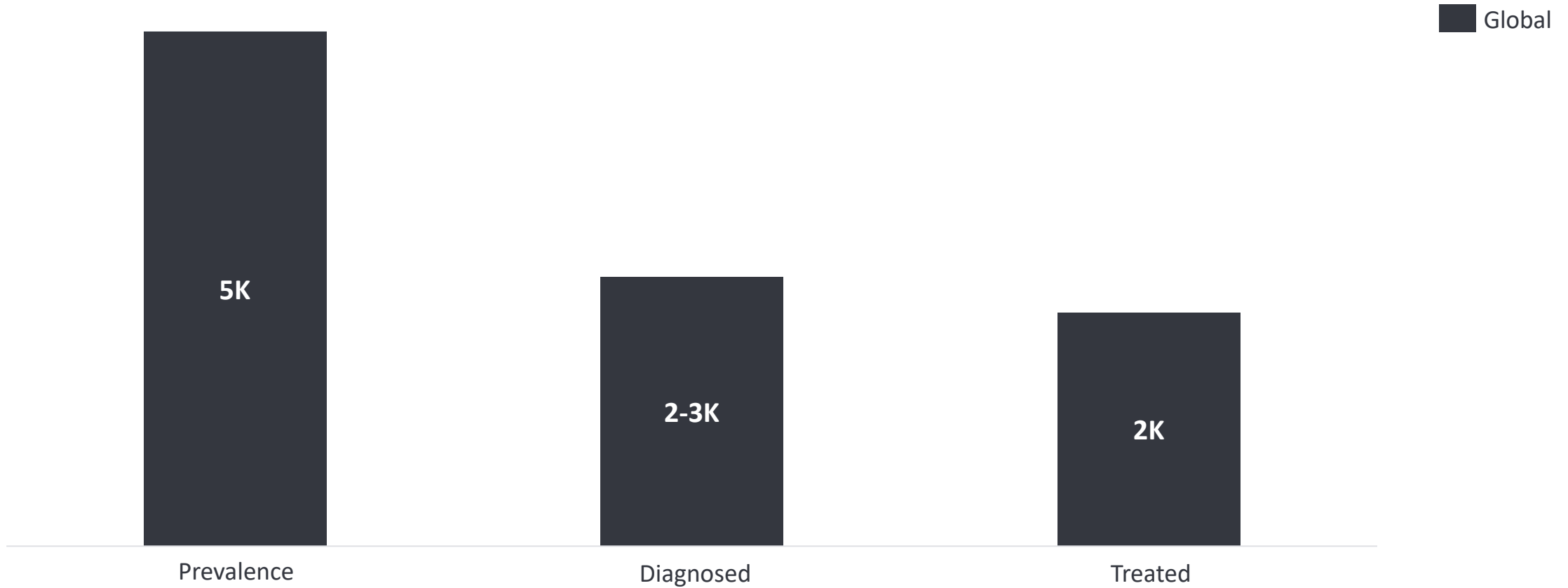

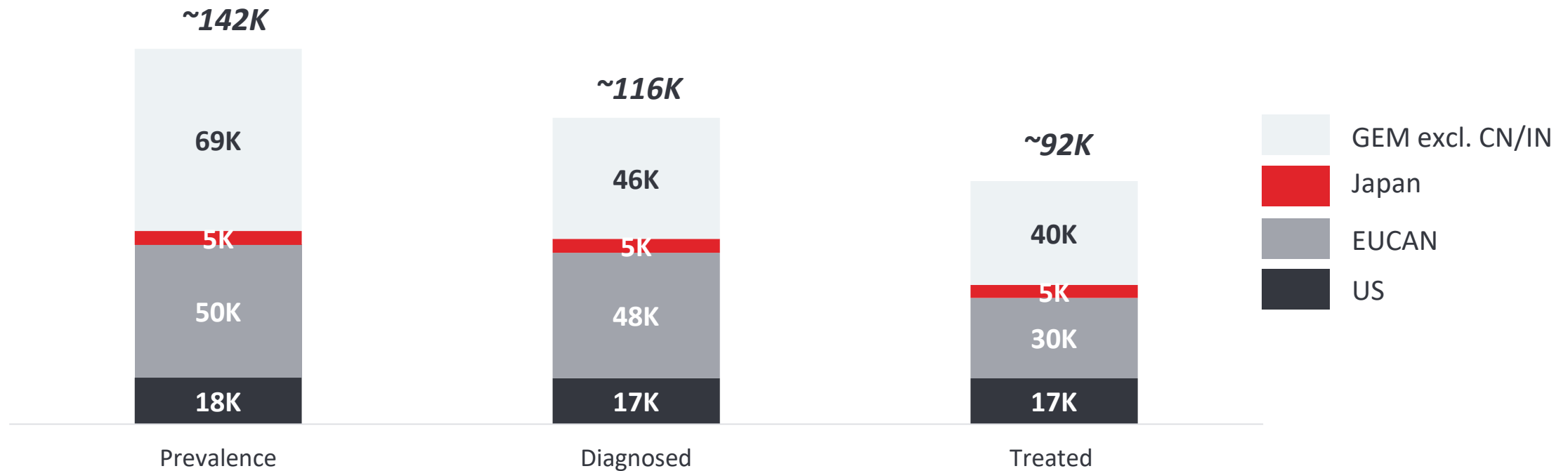
